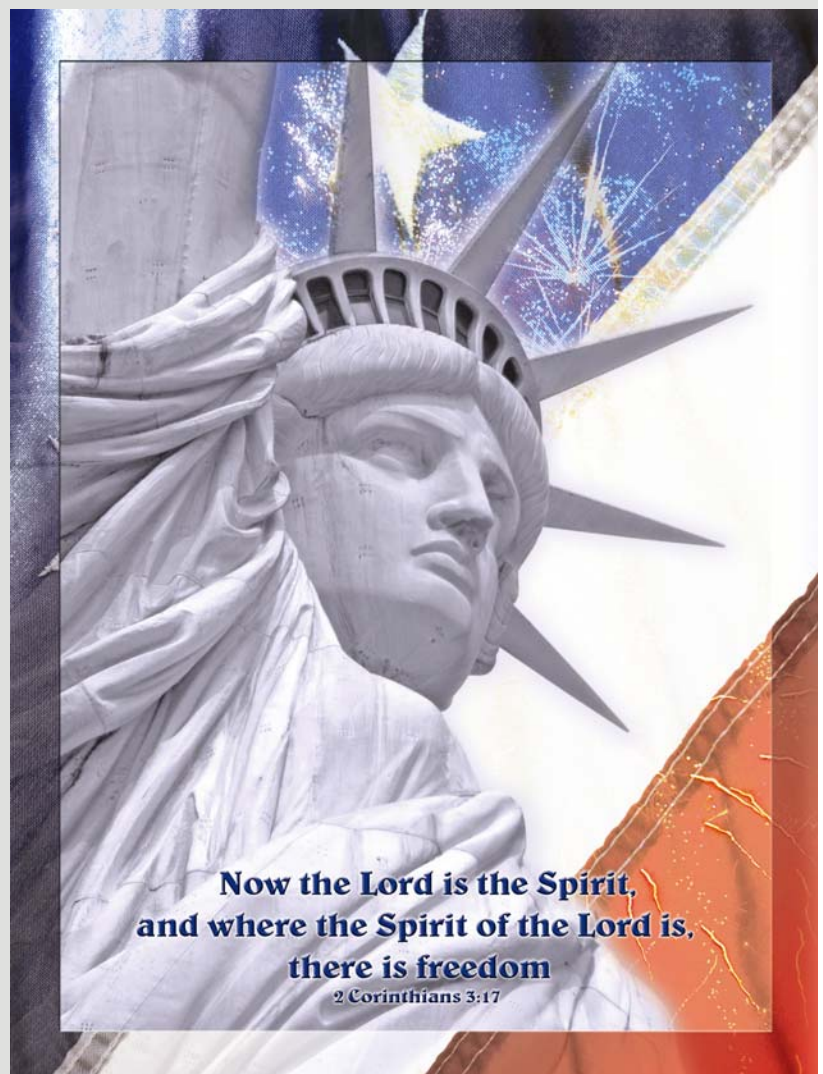

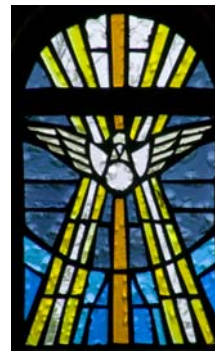
MOM'S DAY OUT REGISTRATION
