

“Dignity for ALL” Retreat

Here are the details of the Deep Freeze retreat this weekend.

Saturday, Feb. 3 at 1:00 (eat lunch before you arrive.) until Sunday, Feb. 4 at 11:00 am.

Camp Christian, directly off of Rangeline Rd. (From Hwy. 90, turn south, go over the interstate, go until you see Rabbit Creek on the right. Turn right on Rabbit Creek Drive. The driveway is almost immediately on the right.)

Bring: \$30, permission slip (see below), large cardboard pieces that can be constructed into a shelter for yourself, sleeping bag and pillow, personal care items, clothes for Mass Sunday (if you are attending 11:30 Mass with the group at St. Dominic).

This retreat is different from most. We will explore human dignity in many ways, especially as it pertains to the homeless. So, please understand that there will be times you might get hungry (we will have dinner- just not anything afterwards), or uncomfortable (sleeping outside in your shelter instead of a warm bed). Cell phones will be put away for a good portion of the time. We will be offering up these discomforts to the Lord for those who have very little.

Some of you who feel comfortable will go to the parking lot of Wal Mart to distribute hot meals to the homeless in the Tillman’s Corner area at around 4.

You may only go if your parent signs the additional place at the bottom of the form. We will be using cars with proper insurance and adult drivers.

NOTE TO PARENTS: We really need a few parents to meet us either at the camp or at the parking lot to help with food distribution. I also need at least one brave parent to stay with us at camp Saturday night. You may have a nice warm bed if you want. Please let me know if you can help out in any way.
