SCHOOL NEWS

St. Dominic Catholic School students take the Iowa Test of Basic Skills annually. Our students this past March received the following composite subject grade level averages: 2nd grade tested at a 3rd grade 3rd month level, 3rd grade tested at a 4th grade 4th month level; 4th grade tested at a 4th grade 8th month level; 5th grade tested at a 6th grade ninth month level; 6th grade tested at a 7th grade level; 7th grade tested at a 8th grade third month level; and 8th grade tested at a 10th grade 4th month level. You will note that all grades are above grade level with some as much as almost $2\frac{1}{2}$ years above their grade. Our students go on to do well in high school and beyond. This past year the Salutatorian at McGill Toolen was Anthony Hantouche from our school. Fifty percent of McGill Toolen National Merit Scholars came from St. Dominic and our students represent 20% of McGill's honor roll students.. We continue to push forward academically and this year our Latin program, Dominicans Scholars, writing and even penmanship will see increased focus. We have adopted a new math textbook series and our math differentiation will continue to see renewed focus by adding accelerated math specifically in middle school but across all grade levels as well.

More important than academics, our students are being formed in faith. We continue to focus on what is true, good and beautiful in our world through our focus on God in and through Jesus with strength from the Holy Spirit. Our students will continue to be "forward thinkers" experiencing and exploring science with a hands-on approach. We embrace technology and its usefulness in our world, but our students' social and emotional learning and well being is paramount. They learn through their experiences at our school how to interact with each other and express themselves in an appropriate way.

We are thankful for the support of our parish and we realize that without you, we would not be here. Our parish family is in the school's intentions everyday. Please continue to pray for all of us as we embrace this Catholic school ministry. It is important for the future of our Church and our world. Our state recognizes the importance of educating children in a place that aligns with parents' values. Signed into law by Governor Kay Ivey on March 7, 2024, the CHOOSE Act makes refundable income tax credits available in an educational savings account (ESA) to pay up to \$7,000 of tuition and other qualifying educational expenses. We will continue to make our community aware of the CHOOSE Act opportunity.
