We installed our 8th grade leaders of the school with soaring eagle pins after our first school Mass. Our faith is the heart and soul of our school and we are blessed to have the ability to pray throughout the day and attend Mass at least once a week with our parish community. Through our ministry of Catholic education we are able to reinforce our faith with a campus of 94% Catholic children while at the same time evangelizing to children of other faith denominations. This year we continue to offer both Spanish and Latin to our middle school students and Spanish to our PK-5th grade students. Dr. McHardy has retooled the Dominican Scholars program and we offer advanced math placement in both 7th and 8th grade. We are adding a stringed instrument class (violin) to our music program as well as piano lessons. Our band program continues with students in the McGill Toolen prep band. Our art program allows students to experience all mediums to express their creativity. In literature, we explore classic novels and expand minds with critical thinking. Our focus on STEM remains strong through all grades. The gym has been refurbished with painting, complete floor restoration and new lighting. Our enrollment is strong with new students in every grade except one. We've managed to keep our tuition increases to a minimum while continuing to keep teacher to student ratios low. We achieve much of this through the monetary sacrifice made by our parents and the generous donations of our parishioners. A simple thank you doesn't seem enough, but it is heartfelt. Our parish community is in the prayers of our school every day. Please continue to pray for the five seminarians who are alumni of our school and one Dominican Sister of St. Cecilia.
