MARRIAGE



The Eucharistic Revival which has been going on for about a year will reach its pinnacle with the Blessed Sacrament being processed across the county on 4 different routes that all culminate in Indianapolis (where the Eucharist Congress is scheduled to be held in July). Our Archdiocese of Mobile is on the Juan Diego Route. At 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 15, Archbishop Rodi will celebrate Mass in the Cathedral-Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. At this Mass he will consecrate the host which will be used for our portion of the Eucharistic Procession. The procession will begin as we recess from Mass. It will end at St. Mary Parish Church with a talk about the connection between being people of the Eucharist and being people of service. After this talk, most pilgrims will be dismissed. (With the exception of those who have volunteered to help stuff bags for distribution to seafarers; materials are provided). There will be a shuttle available to return pilgrims to their cars that were left at the Cathedral. All are welcome to join in this procession.
