### Children and Adolescents Protection Program

We are excited that you have chosen to enroll your child at St. Dominic Catholic School. One of the things that makes SDCS such a wonderful place to learn is our students and their families. There are many opportunities for parents and grandparents to get involved, whether it is as a room mother, coach, PTO volunteer, field trip chaperone, or just helping out in the classrooms for parties and other fun events. **However, to take part in any of these activities you must have completed the initial *Children and Adolescent Protection Program (CAPP)* training or annual retraining.**

The *Archdiocese of Mobile Children and Adolescent Protection Program* training is required for all employees. It is also required of all volunteers (age 18 or older) who have substantial contact with minors. The objective of this program is to provide specific training in the prevention, recognition and reporting of child abuse, as well as specific training in providing for safe environments for minors enrolled in Archdiocesan sponsored activities.

Child protection classes are offered monthly at St. Dominic in the Murphy Center. (See below for remaining 2015 class dates.) The classes last approximately one hour. Participants are also asked to complete a set of screening forms to be used for conducting a required background check on all volunteers and employees.

Once you have completed the initial Child Protection training, each volunteer or employee is required to complete an annual retraining. This retraining should take place during the months of August, September, or October. Annual retraining may be completed online at <https://mobile.cmgconnect.org/>. You will be asked to review certain articles and complete a six question quiz. Once you have completed the quiz successfully, you will be recertified to work with youth for an additional year.
